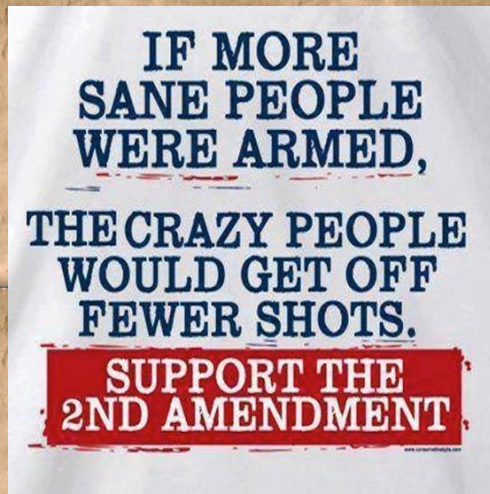

Yup, still waiting.

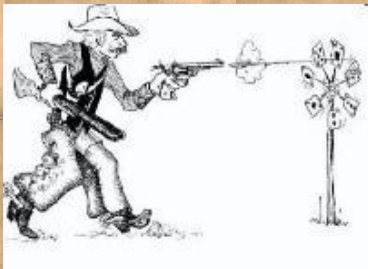
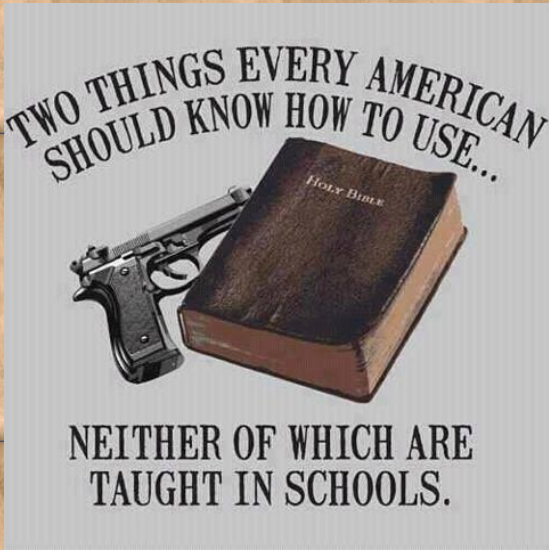
Fact:

Based on this information, to make people safer, should we outlaw:

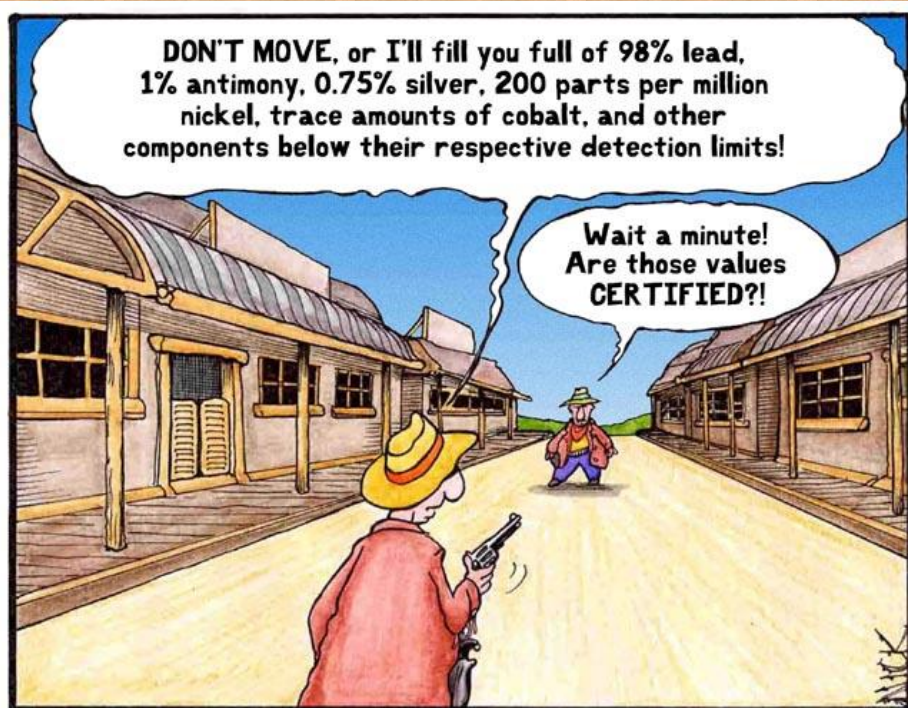
